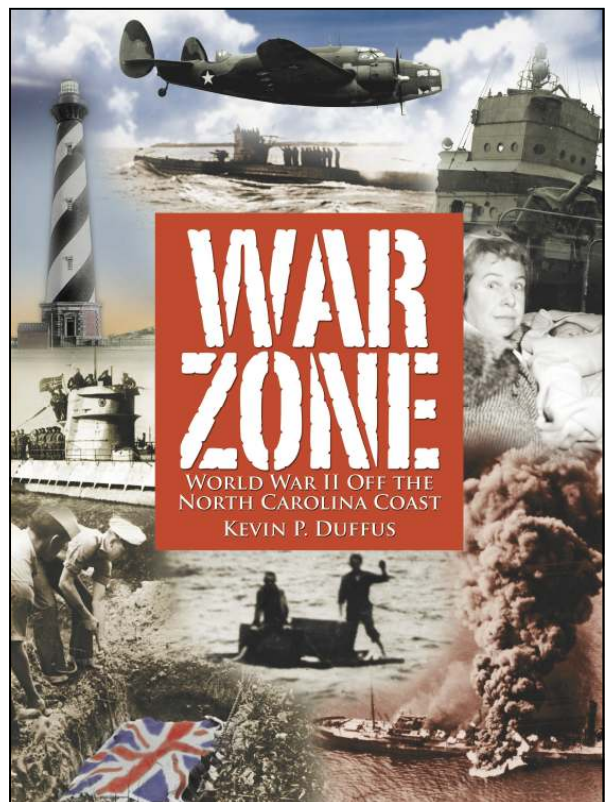
Our last two scheduled events are as follows:
